### *It Might Be Fun*

Sandy's newest album features songs by composer/lyricist Bruce Kimmel, the director/writer/composer of the legendary cult film, *The First Nudie Musical*, director and producer of musical shows for an impressive roster of singers. Bruce also wrote the title songs for Sandy's last two albums, *This Christmas* and *Simply*. The songs on *It Might Be Fun* are as complex and diverse as Mr. Kimmel himself, ranging from dramatic turns about "Falling out of Love" to clever comedic tunes such as "Who Do I Have to Blank to Get Out of This Show?" The album also includes the world premiere recording of a new song by Kimmel and Oscar-winning composer Richard M. Sherman of the Sherman Brothers fame (*Mary Poppins*, *The Jungle Book*, and many other classic Disney films). And as per Mr. Kimmel, the way Sandy beautifully voices and interprets his songs produces an alchemy that cannot be denied.
